In line with the WAGE Strategic Plan, the Executive Committee aims to strengthen and maintain close working relationships with other relevant Welsh, UK, and international organisations.

The Pathology Lead will ensure effective two- way communication between pathologists in Wales and WAGE.

Job Summary

This is an exciting opportunity for a Gastrointestinal Pathologist to undertake a national role as the WAGE Pathology Lead. The WAGE Pathology Lead will develop and maintain a GI Pathology Network and provide advice to the Executive Committee on matters relating to GI Pathology.

The role will require the post holder to work both autonomously and as part of a team to ensure that pathology is represented at WAGE and effective two- way communication is maintained based on the requirements of the WAGE strategic plan and pathology community in Wales. The post holder will become a member of the WAGE Executive Committee and work collaboratively with members for a period of three years.

Key Responsibilities

- To develop and manage the WAGE Pathology Network
- To be the single point of contact for pathology related queries
- To establish a process for gathering relevant professional opinions
- To attend executive committee meetings
- To establish effective two- way communication between the Pathology community and WAGE executive committee
- To provide written and verbal feedback to the WAGE executive committee
- To escalate issues related to Pathology to the WAGE Core Executive Group
- To establish training needs for pathologists and other relevant professionals in Wales
- To collaborate with the WAGE training lead to ensure provision of relevant educational sessions

Expectations/Commitments

- Attendance at all Executive Committee Meetings (minimum of 2 per year)
- Attendance at core executive group meetings as required
- Management of Pathology network in line with terms of reference
